



Mobility Week – Competition Entry Terms and Conditions

Eligibility:

Anyone who is resident in Switzerland or Liechtenstein and are aged 18 or over are eligible to enter the competition.

Anyone who uses the FAIRTIQ app from September 16 - 22, 2021 at least once in the network of the participating partners (AUTO AG Uri, Autobus AG Liestal, Bus und Service AG, Chemins de fer du Jura, Rhätische Bahn AG, Transports publics de la région lausannoise, Transports publics fribourgeois Holding (TPF) SA, Transports Publics Neuchâtelois SA, Zugerland Verkehrsbetriebe AG) will be automatically entered into the Mobility Week competition. The prize draw will be held on September 30, 2021. The winners will be notified personally by email.

Participation in the competition is free of charge and with no obligations attached. No purchase necessary.

Prizes:

Public transport credits worth a total of CHF 2,000 (1x 1,000.00, 2x 500.00), redeemable with the FAIRTIQ app for travels in Switzerland (scope of validity of the "GA travel pass) until 31.12.2022.

Other terms and conditions:

The decision of FAIRTIQ AG is final and no correspondence, except with the winners, will be entered into.
